Online Banking Redesign Delay


Due to some technical issues, the launching of the redesigned Online Banking has been delayed. We will keep you posted as we get more information.

Mother's Day

Mother's Day has a touching origin, tracing back to the efforts of Anna Jarvis in the early 20th century. Anna's own mother, Ann Reeves Jarvis, was an activist who cared for wounded soldiers on both sides of the American Civil War, and later worked to promote peace and public health. After her mother's death in 1905, Anna sought to honor her and all mothers. In 1908, she held a memorial for her mother in Grafton, West Virginia, and began campaigning for a nationally recognized Mother's Day. Her efforts bore fruit in 1914, when President Woodrow Wilson officially declared the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. Initially, Anna envisioned the day as a time for children to honor the sacrifices their mothers made for them. Over time, it has evolved into a day of expressing love and gratitude to all maternal figures, celebrating their nurturing and unconditional love.
